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



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

She has worked with many magazines ranging from fine art magazines (where she is able to show her versatility and styles) to newsstand tattoo magazines, and has graced the cover of International newsstand tattoo magazines as well. She is a member of the Sullen Angels, an elite group of tattoo models, a promo model for Charliez Angelz, and a FetCat for the fine art magazine FetErotica. So far she has been on the cover of 28 magazines.

Her love for the tattoo industry has been strong since she started working in shops nine years ago. She is a Cosmetic Tattoo Artist based out of Olde City Tattoo in Philadelphia that has been collecting tattoos for over 21 years (with no plans to stop in the near future!) Her favorite tattoo is on her neck that consist of a bearded vulture, a California condor, and filigree done by Bobby Johnson (Instagram @glendalebully) who tattoos at Grand Reaper in San Diego. ## Ruby Derriere


