Her specialty is large tattoos that are custom designed. In her free time Katlin races downhill mountain bikes.

She was born and raised in the Northeast Kingdom and furthered her education in Vermont. Art sparked an interest from a young age and Katiln sold her first piece at the age of 14 in Stansted, Quebec. Her art can currently be viewed at Rock Art Brewery in Morrisville VT.


I have now been successfully operating Live Iron


