I did my first tattoo in a secret location in Maryland in 1990, with a specific purpose in mind. It's long since been concealed, but it served its purpose. I'll get back to that.

Next stop, San Francisco. It wasn't a novice-friendly town for me. So I taught myself the trade while a nurse buddy taught me BBP & CC guidelines. I'd known AIDS casualties, so healthcare protocol was a must. To this day, I cringe when I hear about 'tattoo parties' or slack practices in shops. But people and health departments vary rather dramatically from place to place, and ultimately all you can do is cover your, and your client's ass.

After a couple years, we left the beautiful, haunted City by the Bay. I packed us up for a trek into the desert Southwest. We landed in Albuquerque where I tattooed in a couple of joints just long enough to leave. It's absolutely gorgeous, but there's no air. Green Chili stew and no motorcycle helmet law just weren't enough to save it. Life goes into storage and we're off the Pacific Northwest on two wheels.

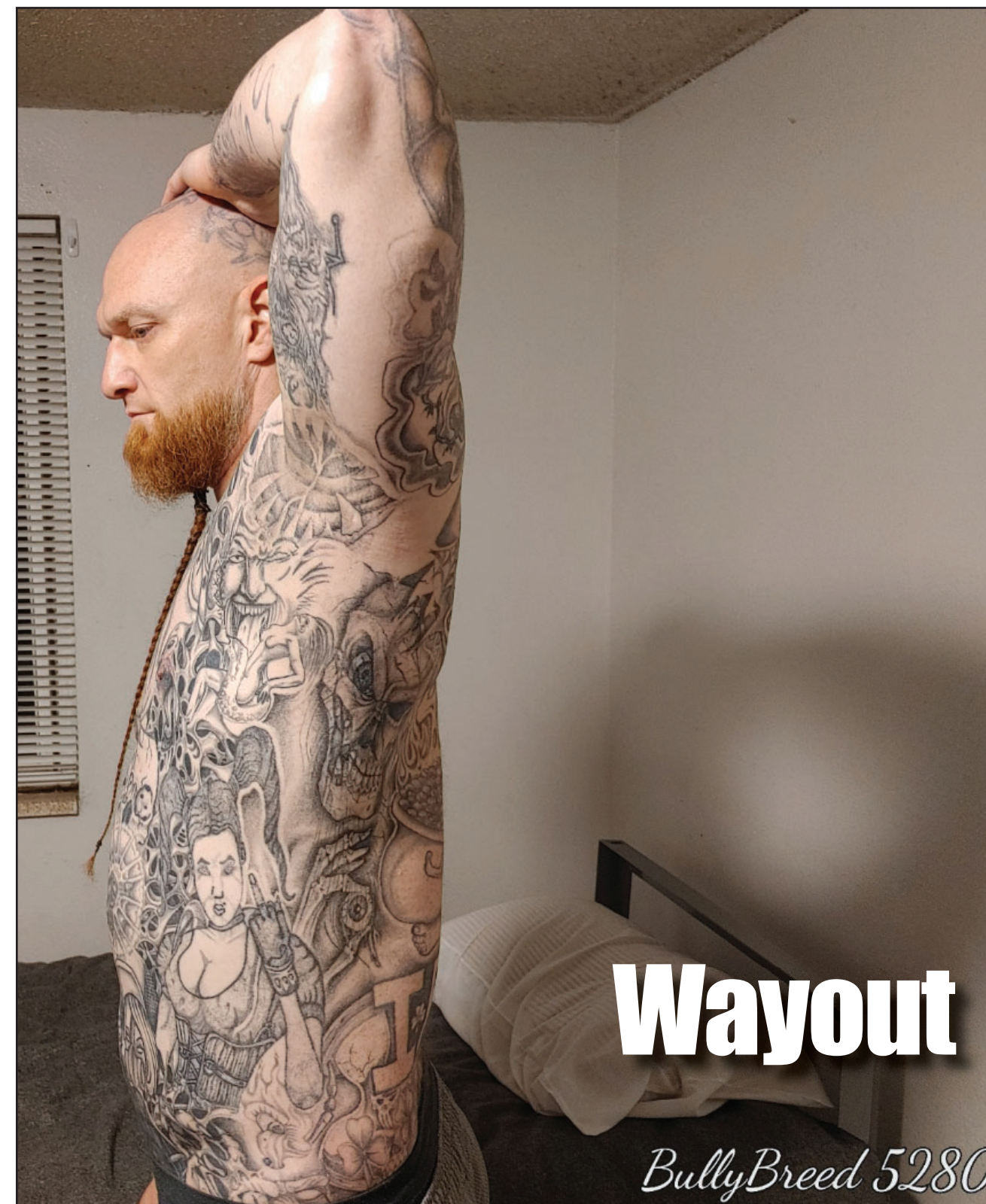
In the City of Roses I did several thousands of tattoos, attested to just before leaving Oregon, by the boxes of least that many release forms. In that state's oldest shop for ten and a half years, I'd drag myself in around five or six pm, frequently not leaving till sunrise. Work spanned everything from gag to religious tattoos, everybody's portrait, and conceptual and surreal pieces to leather and kink tattoos. Some of my fondest memories are of creative clients with wild imaginations and working while we laughed our asses off. Tall ceilings afforded lots of room for my paintings, illustrations, cartoons, and the flash I once created. Though I'd have loved to stay on my home coast, the mojo ran out and premonitions moved in.

My partner's home is Maryland. After kicking around eminently forgettable establishments, I snapped up a little hole in the 'hood. Though I've been seeking better digs for thirteen years, it's mine and I don't have to answer to anyone's bullshit. Fortunately, there are those who don't want the cheapest, most gentrified, or trendiest spots. They want art that resonates with them. It's these people I'm grateful to, but none more than my partner of 31 years who pushed me in this direction. I expected to be recording with my band and doing art shows at this stage, but the world and businesses have changed. As long as people get tattooed, hopefully I'll still have a niche.

Regarding these tattoos, the folks come and go, but the work is original, and it's mine. I hope you like them.

And that first tattoo? That was to prove commitment, and it worked. Moral of the story? To hell with people who don't understand getting your sweetie's name.

As the motorcycle ad used to say; "If I have to explain, you wouldn't understand."

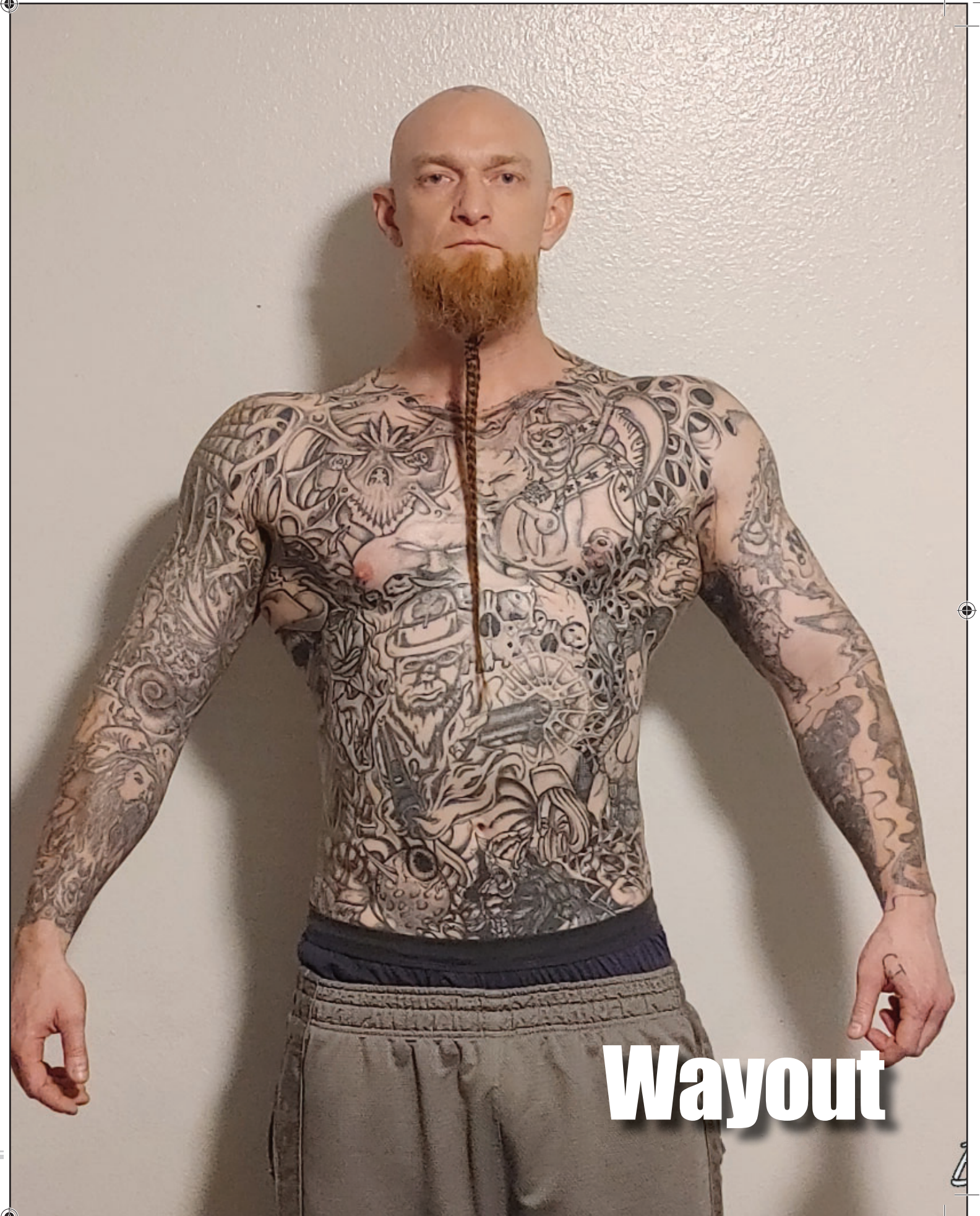

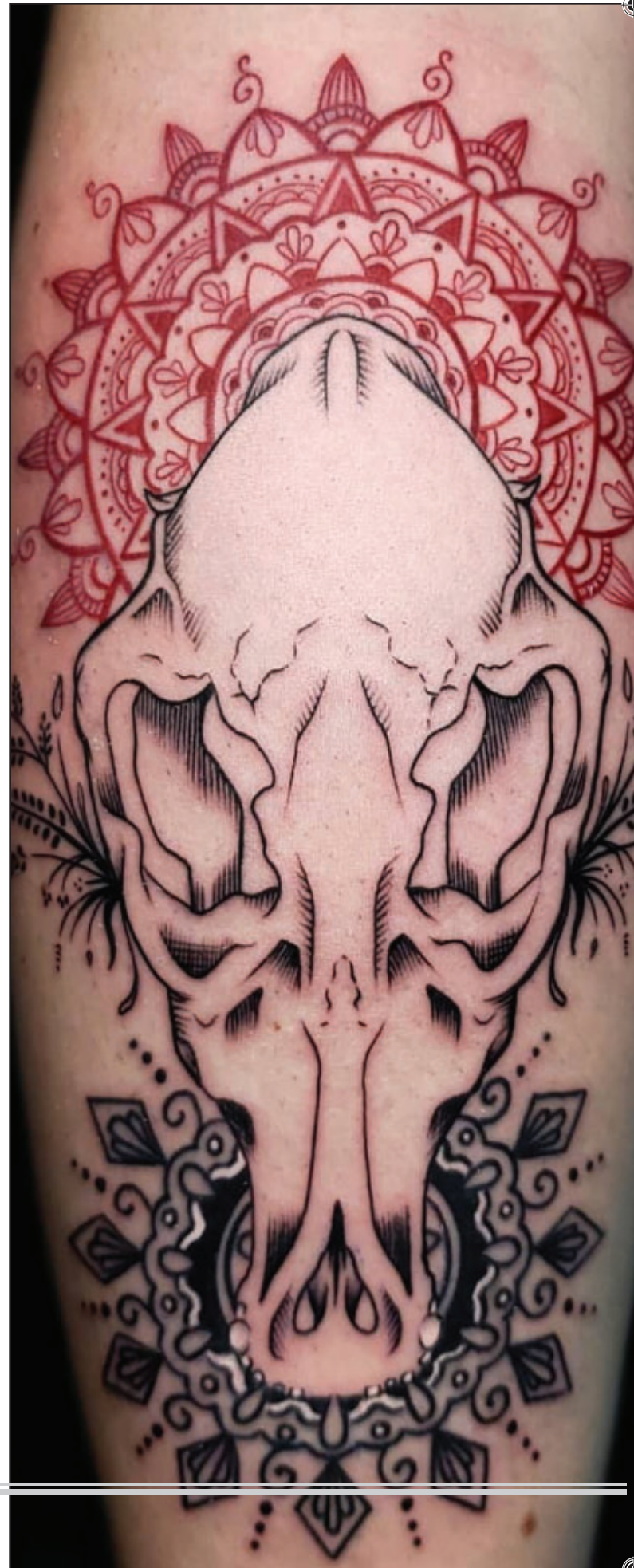
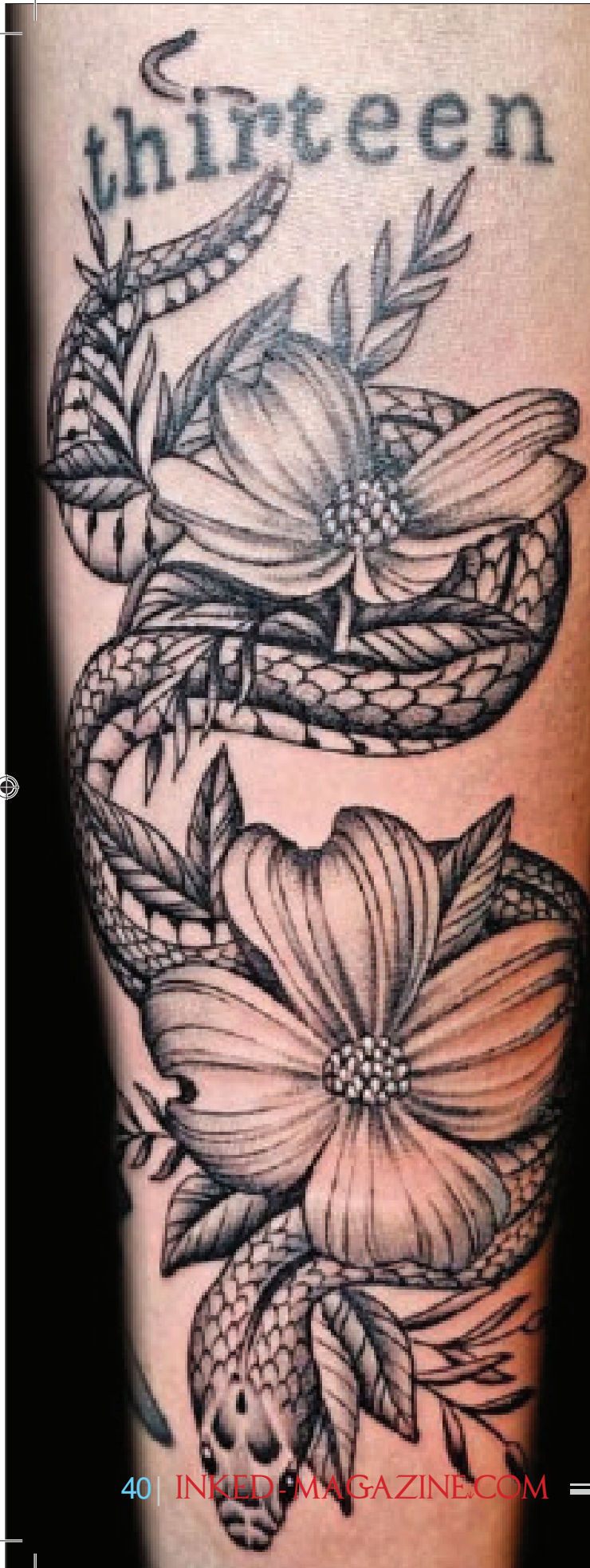
"I understand people from all walks of life want to get a tattoo for countless various reasons, & sometimes

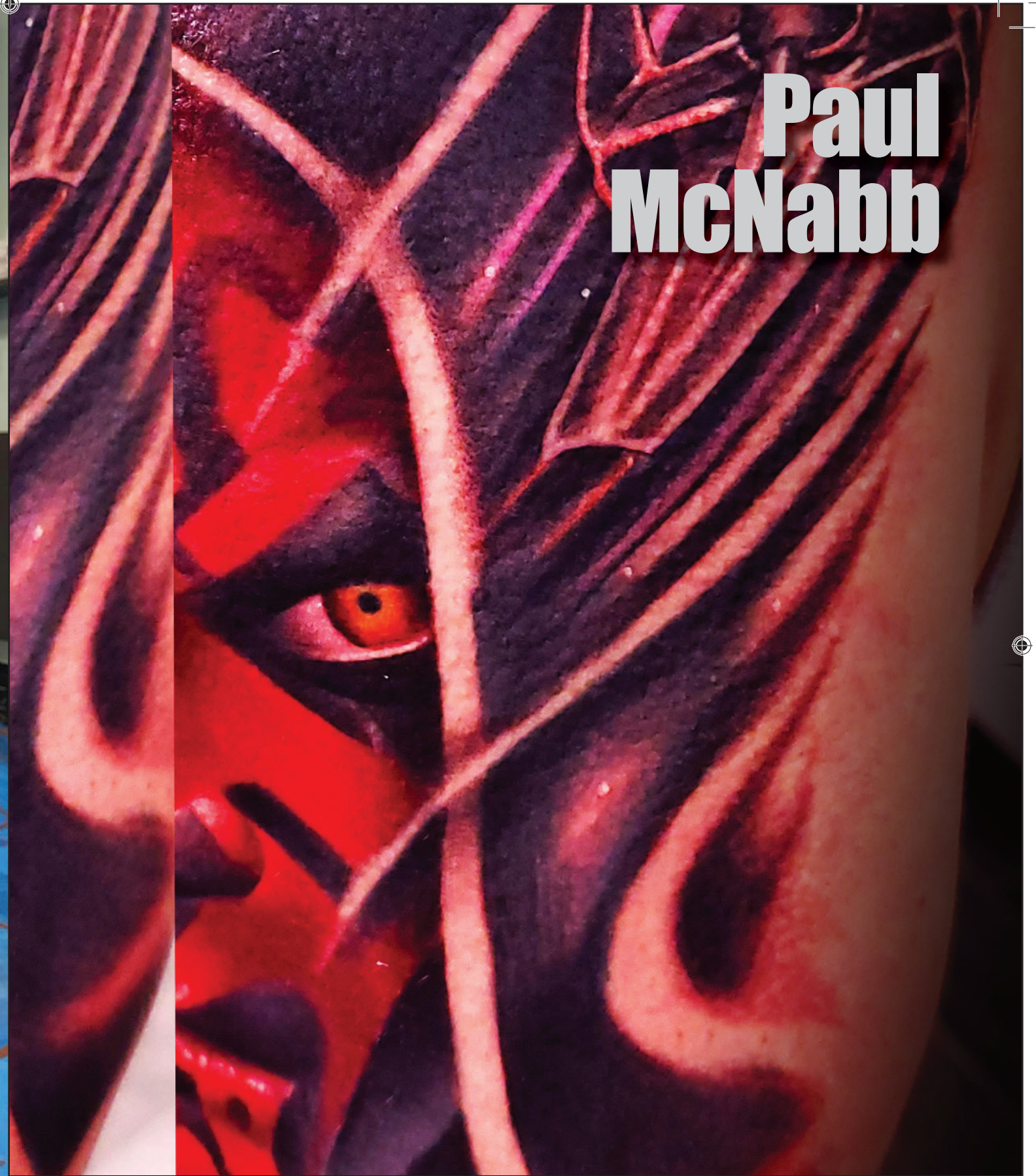

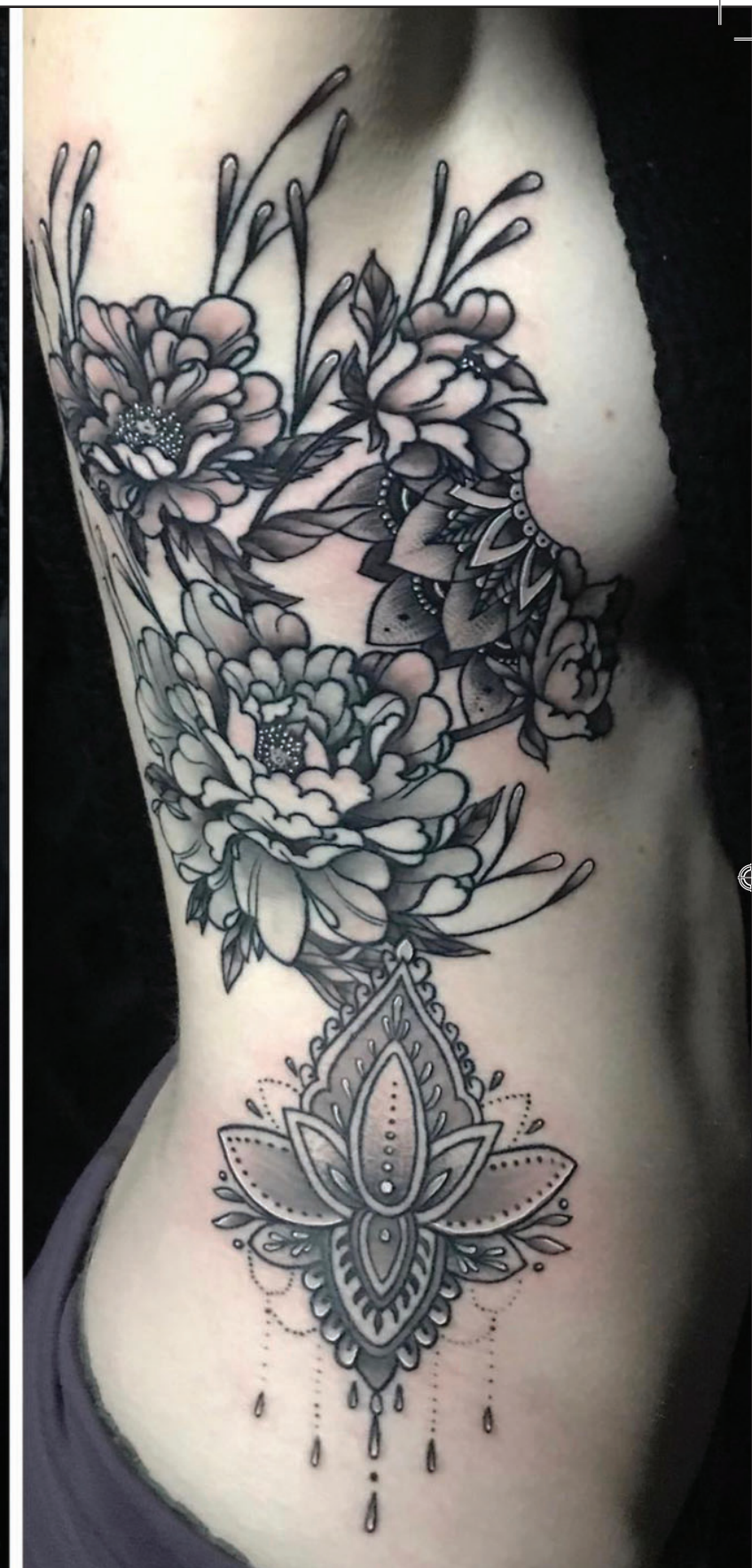
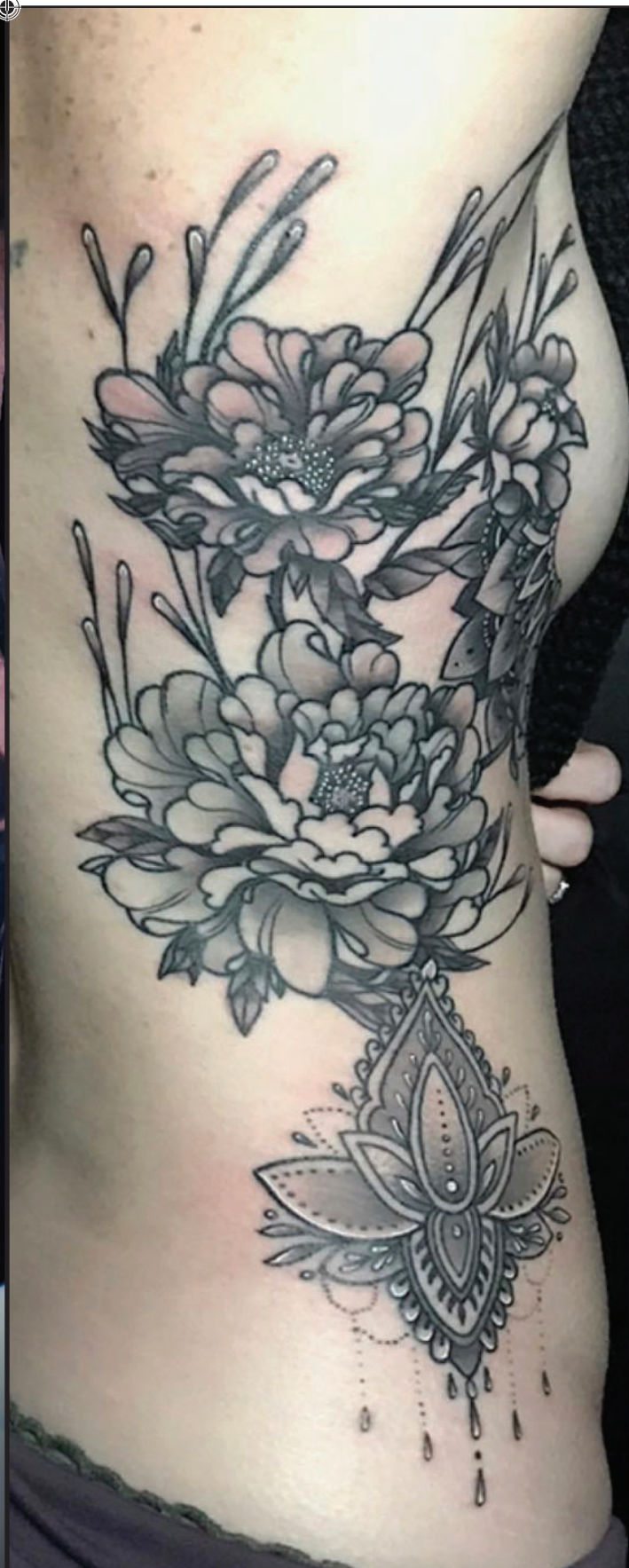
