






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

If I wanted more than that my only obvious choice was to relocate but I didn't just wanna move to any big city. I wanted to do big things, become the part of something more, I had to think internationally. I knew I had to learn English if I wanna achieve something in life and this was the best opportunity for that. Moved to London, just to start again everything from the scratch. I did what pretty much everyone in the industry, started moving from shop to shop building up my skills to become a competitive artist and gain recognition of my peers and the wider audience. I found myself becoming friends with people I've only seen before in magazines and getting sponsorship offers from companies I could only have dreamed of being a part of. And where does it end for me?









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















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














I got into tattooing at the age of 18. I liked to draw growing up and was always fascinated with tattoos. I really liked the idea of making some art on people's

I never thought I'd be a tattoo artist at the time. I was busy getting in trouble and doing drugs. At the age of 18 I was sent to prison for selling drugs and burglaries. I was just a kid sentenced to 8 years in prison. I was scared and needed a outlet to help me get through it all, so I started drawing to pass my time.

Drawing for me took me out of the place I was in and let me create worlds through my art. It was an escape. Later I was encouraged to start tattooing. I was scared. The last thing I wanted was to make a bunch of people mad at me for messing up a tattoo on them in a place where people don't mess around.

Every tattoo I did I put my all into and everyone loved my work. Before too long I had a waiting list of people who would do anything to get in with me. For me tattooing saved me.

When I got released I made a little prison gun and did a tattoo on my brother. We walked into a shop and showed them my work and they were blown away. I not only did an amazing tattoo but also built all the equipment to do it with household items. I was hired on the spot.

I never looked back. I just kept working hard at doing the best I could and learning the most I could. I traveled around the United States for about 7 years. I tattooed in idaho then Michigan then to Florida down to California and back to Idaho.

It was cool to see how so many States did things differently. Different styles and content and ways of putting them together. I got to meet some really cool people and a few big names. I shook David Bolts hand and bought a flash piece from him. Met tattoo Johnny and Joe Capabionco. I was a nobody at the time just happy to be in the same spot as them. I always told myself one day I'd be a big name too.

Sometimes people ask me if I regret going to prison and for making bad choices. I don't, I believe everything happens for a reason. Im a great man today and think mistakes are part of growth. Had I never gone to prison I'd never would have tattooed.

I hope people hear my story and it inspres them to make that change in their life to do something with it. I hope it shows them that anyone can turn around their life and make something out of it. If you believe in yourself you can do anything. Never let a bad decision define you.


Im blessed with a great family and group of friends who are all supportive of me. I wanna thank all of them and especially my clients who are happy to patiently wait their turn.




